Supervisor: Good morning! You must be Carlos. Welcome to the **crew** / **foundation**.

Carlos: Good morning! Yes, that's me. Thank you.

Supervisor: Before we start, have you worked on a **scaffolding** / **construction** site before?

Carlos: Yes, I have some experience, but this is my first job here.

Supervisor: No problem. First things first: **PPE** / **EPP** is mandatory at all times **on site** / **blueprint**.

Carlos: Okay. What do I need?

Supervisor: Hard hat, **steel-toed boots** / **hammer**, gloves, and **safety glasses** / **sunglasses**. Do you have them?

Carlos: I have a **hard hat** / **shift** and **drill** / **gloves**, but I still need the boots and safety glasses.

Supervisor: That's okay. We have some extra safety glasses in the trailer. For the boots, talk to the foreman before your shift starts.

Carlos: Perfect, thank you.

Supervisor: Your **shift** / **concrete** today is from seven to three thirty. The crew starts early, so make sure you're on site by seven.

Carlos: Got it. I'll be here on time.

Supervisor: Good. Today, we're working near the **foundation / drywall**. Let me show you the **blueprint / ladder** so you understand the plan.

Carlos: Okay, I see. Are we working on this section here?

Supervisor: Exactly. We need to finish this section before the **deadline / shift** on Friday.

Carlos: Alright. What do you need me to do first?

Supervisor: For now, help the crew **load / lift** and **unload / measure** materials near the truck.

Carlos: Sure, no problem.

Supervisor: Be careful when you **lift / gloves** and **carry / truck** heavy materials. Use your legs, not your back.

Carlos: Got it. Safety first.

Supervisor: Exactly. Also, **watch out / make sure** for the **cables / scaffolding** near the east wall. The ground is uneven there.

Carlos: Thanks for the warning. I'll be careful.

Supervisor: Good. Later, we'll **measure / unload** the **drywall / concrete** and mark where we need to cut.

Carlos: Sounds good. Do you want me to bring the **drill / helmet**?

Supervisor: Not yet. First, bring the **deadline / hammer** and the tool belt from the trailer.

Carlos: Okay. Hammer and tool belt.

Supervisor: Perfect. And remember, if you don't understand something, ask me or the **foreman / worker**.

Carlos: Okay, thank you. I appreciate it.

Supervisor: No problem. Let's get started.
